Sir,

The indigenous faith-followers of the Galo tribes are informed that the Galo Welfare Society (GWS) has acquired GI numbers for various Galo textile items vide GI registration no referred above.

In light of this, I think it's crucial to inform you that, of all the textiles that have been registered, the "JESE KOORE or TAKOM LEBOK" is a sacred garment worn during AI-AGAM rites only. If non-believers of the Galo ancestor faith are engaged in the promotion of such sacred garments, the dignity of JESE KOORE may not be upheld.

Therefore, the Galo indigenous faith organization/society or any Galo ancestral faith believers should be the only ones to engage in any future endeavors and promotion of the JESE KOORE textiles which are deeply ingrained ritual-connected textile items.

I hope our recommendation to steer clear of religious sentiments is accepted, as this is essential to preserving social harmony and peace.
